

## Website and Social Media Management Intern

Educators for Socially Responsible Apparel Practices (ESRAP) seeks an intern to manage their website regarding layout, design, and content updates, along with other social media platforms. Responsibilities will vary depending on applicant experience, but may include any combination of the following:

- Work with ESRAP committee representative to maintain and update website content
- Develop new content consistent with the organization's purpose
- Manage Facebook page and other social media spaces
- Manage ESRAP blog
- Coordinate content with the organization's social media presence

The intern will:

- Be enrolled full-time in a relevant undergraduate program, junior or senior status
- Work collaboratively with committee representative to complete assigned tasks
- Work independently to maintain and update content
- Possess a strong level of attention to detail

To apply for this internship, applicants should demonstrate qualifications for this internship by submitting:

- A letter of interest, describing prior experience that well-positions the candidate for this role
- Examples of relevant work, which must include one each of the following:
  - Sample writing (research paper, creative writing, blog post, etc.)
  - Creative work (created website, graphic design project, apparel line board, etc.) via a file attachment, link, or other digital format
- One letter of recommendation from an academic advisor, professor, or internship supervisor
